- Long Island is home to 109 independent school districts
- With the 2011 passage of a 2% tax cap by the New York State Legislature, the question of the cost effectiveness and sustainability of Long Island's independent school districts has come into focus.
- Rising rates of immigration in conjunction with declining school enrollment rates will force schools to provide more services for students with less available resources.
